Project Summary

The main focus of the project is to propagate Human Right Education among Sierra Leoneans.

The aim of the project is to create the required awareness-raising about the fundamental rights and dignity of people.

The objectives are to galvanize the energies, expertise and resources of Human Rights organizations to address cases of Human Rights violations, and to popularize human rights education through procession, seminars, radio discussion programmes and jingles.

The target beneficiaries include Sierra Leoneans, especially students of secondary and tertiary institutions, NGO's, CBO's and Human Right Institutions.

The activities of the project would include an organization of a meeting with Human Right Groups, and other stakeholders, writing of invitation letter to schools, colleges and civil society groups, printing of education promotional leaflets, the formation of a planning and implementation committees to plan the necessary activities, organizations of a procession of Human Right Institution and other stakeholders.

Dramatization of Human Right starts during the one day seminar, and an organization of radio discussion programmes in selected radio stations.

The proposed budget for the implementation of this project would cost:

Project Rationale

The main thrust of the project is to accelerate the process of effective Human Rights Educations among the Sierra Leonean citizenry.

It is very obvious that with adequate knowledge and education of the characteristics and categories of Human Rights, as well as, intervention mechanisms, the fundamental rights and dignity of people will continue to be jeopardized.

However, undertaking this project would help sensitize and dramatically instill in the minds of the wider citizenry of Sierra Leone, about their Civil and Political Rights (these are “liberty oriented” and includes the rights to life, liberty, security, freedom from torture, slavery and freedom of opinion, etc.

Their “Economic and Social Rights” which are “Security oriented” and include rights to work, education, a reasonable standard of living, food, shelter and health care; their environmental, cultural and developmental rights, which include the rights to live in an environment that is clean and protected from destruction and economic developments.

Additionally, bringing together various youth serving organizations, community based organizations, non-governmental organizations, partners in the Diaspora and government official would create a vibrant network of communication, a team of monitors and advocates, to prevent the occurrence of Human Rights violations and abuses.

Also the network would help promote and protect the rights of people through rigorous and dramatic Human Rights Education, as well as monitoring and advocacy.

Moreover, the project’s rationale lies its provision and communication of Human Rights facts or ideas to target audiences, educating the powerful to change and the powerless to act, advocate for their conditions in which people achieve their rights; including a help to bring violators to justice.

AIM

The main aim of the project is to raise awareness and educate the wider citizenry of Sierra Leone about their fundamental Human Rights.

Objective

- To galvanize the energies, expertise and Human Resources of Human Rights Organizations to prevent Human Rights violations.
- To popularize Human Rights, Education through a dramatic process of Students, processions, seminar, radio discussion programmes and jingles.

The project mainly target every Sierra Leonean, especially students of secondary and tertiary institutions, NGO's, CBO's and Human Right Institutions..

All of the above activities would be done on the 10th December, 2008, ‘ ‘ The Day of the Human Rights.’ ’

The event would start with a procession which would culminate into a seminar at the Miatta Conference Hall, during which skits would be dramatized by schools on Human Rights Education as well as a release of Position Statement and Solidarity Statement delivered by Human Rights Institutions. The event would end with radio discussion programmes.
